



## 2022 RULES AND ENTRY FORMS

### THEME: RVA NEIGHBORHOODS

#### EVENT DESCRIPTION

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The fifth annual Gingerbread House Challenge taking place at Hardywood Richmond on Sunday, November 13, 2022, dares local businesses, nonprofits, student groups, and artists to form teams and *literally* display their holiday spirit and creativity by constructing a gingerbread house centered around the 2022 theme, “RVA Neighborhoods”. Hosted by BHCyp, the young professionals board of the Better Housing Coalition, event attendees will vote on their favorite displays, and an expert judging panel will crown the \$1,000 Grand Prize Winner! Houses will be up for auction, and 100% of proceeds will support BHC’s mission of changing lives and transforming communities through high-quality affordable housing. So don’t be a Scrooge - join the fun and support a great cause!

#### ENTRIES AND EVALUATION

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##### Theme:

The 2022 theme is “**RVA Neighborhoods**”; entries are not limited to the structure of a house. Competitors are welcome and encouraged to uniquely design their entry for the competition, as long as the entry is in keeping with the competition rules and procedures and the judging criteria. Think about the architecture, history, community events, people, and landmarks that make your neighborhood of choice special.

Competitors may choose the same neighborhood but will not be allowed to represent the same subject that another registrant has previously selected. Subjects are first come, first served. You may see a listing of competitors and their selections [here](#).

##### Size Limits:

Entry must be placed on a base. Entries combined with a base must not be larger than 24 inches high, 24 inches wide, and 24 inches long. We suggest using ½” or ¾” plywood as a base for your entry. Use of pegs or risers on the bottom of the base is encouraged for ease of transport but not required. **If you wish to install “legs” on the underside of your base, the legs are considered as part of the base and should not cause the entry’s height to exceed 24 inches.**

##### Materials:

All visible elements of your entry must be edible; interior structures are allowed to be made of non-edible material. The main structure of your entry must be constructed from gingerbread, some of which should be exposed. Edible materials are not limited to candies and icings. Handmade elements are encouraged. Note that refrigeration for entries will not be provided.

Entrants will not be provided with a power source; should you choose to add lighted or powered elements, they should be battery powered. Non-edible materials such as paint and/or ribbon are approved only to decorate the outer edge of your

base only (not to exceed the length and/or width of the base). All structures must be free standing with the ability for judges to view on all sides.

**Entry Narrative:**

**Each team is required to submit a brief narrative no later than Sunday, November 6.** Tell the adoring public why your design is the best! How did you decide on your design? How does it fit the theme of the competition? What does it say about your organization or team? Narratives will be included in a guidebook so guests can find your entry to cast their vote. **Please keep your narrative to 200 words or less.**

**Voting and Judging Criteria:**

**Judging Panel:**

The expert judging panel will evaluate entries on 1) Overall Appearance, 2) Originality, 3) Difficulty, and 4) Consistency of Theme. You can see last year's judging rubric [HERE](#).

For juried prize, decorative elements that are handmade will carry more weight than similar prefabricated items. All rulings by the judges are independent and final; they are in no way influenced by BHCYP members or affiliates. In the event of a tie, the competition Call Judge will be asked to break the tie.

**You are required to have a team representative present during judging and awards ceremony;** judging will be held on Sunday, November 13, 2022 at 11AM with an Awards Ceremony held at approximately 5PM.

**People's Choice Voting:**

NEW THIS YEAR: Each team will be given the opportunity to share a donation link two weeks prior to the competition to allow supporters to "vote" for your entry even if they are unable to attend the event. We will provide you with ideas to share with your network to make it as easy as possible.

We encourage teams to have representatives present throughout the competition to drum up excitement and capture public votes, however it is not required.

**Prizes:**

Prize checks will be sent to the winners after the competition and will be mailed to the address that is provided on the entry form. In the event a team entry wins a prize, the team captain will be the recipient of any prizes and is responsible for distributing to the team members as he/she sees fit.

- Juried Grand Prize: \$1,000
- Juried Runner Up: \$500
- People's Choice: \$500

## REGISTRATION

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**Teams:**

Due to spacing requirements, the number of entrants will be limited to a total of 18. You are encouraged to submit your entry form early and before the deadline to ensure entry into the competition. To be eligible for the competition, a completed and signed copy of **Competitor Entry Form must be received by email at [s.fernald@betterhousingcoalition.org](mailto:s.fernald@betterhousingcoalition.org) prior to 11:59PM on Sunday, October 16, 2022.** Entries that are not pre-registered will not be accepted.

Teams are limited to 2-6 participants. Individuals will not be considered. The Competitor Entry Form must be signed by all members of the team (and parent/guardian where necessary), and one member must be designated the Team Captain. Team Captains must be older than 18 years of age at the time of the competition date and all team members must be committed to only one team. Discovery that greater than six people have worked on any element of the final gingerbread house is grounds for disqualification and forfeiture of registration fee.

Subjects represented in displays will be claimed on a first come, first served basis, and multiple teams will not be permitted to depict the same subject matter. BHCyp reserves the right to refuse any entry deemed inappropriate. **Entry Fee:**

To complete registration, your team's **\$100 entry fee must be received by Monday, October 24, 2022**. *Please note that entry numbers are assigned once entry fee is received, and entry number determines placement within the competition.*

BHCYP understands that situations may cause competitors to withdraw from the competition. **COVID Accommodations:**

BHCyp is closely monitoring the situation with the pandemic. In the unlikely event that it is determined that the competition must move to a virtual format, we will notify teams with as much advance notice as possible. In the event that we do move to a virtual format, below is the plan of action.

**Judging:** Teams will deliver their entries to a predetermined location for judging on November 13 where they will be evaluated by our expert judges panel. The same criteria will apply as above. Captains or team representatives will be given a time slot to attend the judging or video call with the panel to give insight into your team's process, details, etc. The results from the juried part of the competition will determine the \$1000 Juried Grand Prize and \$500 Runner Up winners.

**People's Choice:** In the event that we must switch to a virtual format, teams wishing to compete in the people's choice competition will participate in a week long social media and fundraising campaign starting November 14 and concluding on November 20. Teams will create a fundraising page with Just Giving specifically for your entry. After registering, you will be provided with language, prompts and ideas to share your story. All the funds raised by your team support BHC's mission.

Awards for both the juried and people's choice competitions will be announced virtually on Tuesday, November 22, time TBD.
